# Upcoming Mandarin II Summer Assignment

Dear Mandarin II takers,



All of you should have total 110 character flashcards. These 110 character flashcards will be checked again when you come back in September.

You need to apply one compound on the back of each character flashcard and build two sentences in Chinese characters everyday on the composition notebook you have used to build character stories. You are encouraged to build various sentences and apply as many terms as you have learned in your sentences. You need to start from #1 until finishing all of the character flashcards. You are allowed to have one English word or pinyin if you don't know how to write the term in Chinese character for each sentence you'll build.

You are also encouraged to revisit your class notes and review Ni Hao 1 textbook software that you have asked to install in your computer at the beginning of last semester. Don't use google translation, or other forms of translation. Ms. Chau will know, and you will need to rewrite all of your sentences.


