

## Getting started with Turnitin.com for Students

**If you have never used Turnitin, follow Part A & B. If you already have a Turnitin login, follow only Part B.**

### A. CREATE A STUDENT USER ACCOUNT

Students will need to know the *class ID* and the course *enrollment password* from their sponsor/teacher before logging on to turnitin.com. They also must have a personal e-mail address.

1. Browse to the MHS home page [www.millenniumhs.org](http://www.millenniumhs.org). Click on Academics > Exhibitions.
2. On the Exhibitions page, click on Links, and then click on Turnitin.
3. In the section “New Students start here,” click “Create a user profile.”

8. Remember your password and never share it with anyone.

### B. ADD YOURSELF TO YOUR CLASS

1. On your home page in turnitin, click on “enroll in a class.”
2. Enter the class ID and enrollment password your teacher/sponsor gave you, and click Submit.
