

## 2019-2020 MHS Basic Supply List

This is a suggested list to get you started on shopping. Supplies may vary slightly by teacher.

### Science:

1 ½ - 2" binder (may be shared with other class) Scientific or graphing calculator (TI-84 suggested)  
4 dividers \$30 Lab Fee

### Math:

1 ½ - 2" binder (may be shared with other class) 1 pad of graph paper (for Algebra only)  
4 dividers Wescott compass (for Geometry only)  
Composition grid notebook Scientific or graphing calculator (TI-83 suggested – can  
Pencils (preferably mechanical) be same one as used for science)  
Metric ruler

### English:

1 ½ - 2" binder (may be shared with other class) *A Pocket Style Manual* by Diana Hacker  
3 packs of post-its (3X3, multicolored)  
3 dividers

### History:

1.5" binder (not shared) for 9-12 grades  
100 page single subject notebook (UH students)

### Foreign Language:

1 ½" binder (not shared) For Spanish: Spanish-English Dictionary  
4 dividers For Mandarin: Chinese-English Dictionary  
One folder  
2 packs of index cards (3X5)  
Composition notebook

### Art:

1 unlined 9x12 sketchbook (preferably spiral bound) \$10 Supply Fee  
Pencils and erasers  
Photography (UH only): 1.5" binder with loose leaf and 25 clear, plastic sheet protectors

### Health (9<sup>th</sup> grade only):

1 or 1 ½" binder (or section of any shared binder)  
Folder for handouts

### Physical Education:

Combination lock \$5 Equipment Repair Fee  
Gym clothes (see Student Handbook for more info) \$8 T-Shirt Fee (new students only)  
Notebook (used all four years)

### General (for all classes):

Loose-leaf paper (college ruled)  
Highlighter pens in different colors  
Sharpies or markers  
Black or blue pens  
Combination lock (*in addition* to lock for PE)  
USB flash drive (4GB or higher)  
Paper and printer ink/toner
